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## Health Information Technology (HIT) Toolkit for Family Physicians

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### Five Things to Do NOW

1. Determine if you qualify for the Medicare or Medicaid EHR Incentive Programs by visiting [https://www.cms.gov/EHRIncentivePrograms/15\\_Eligibility.asp#TopOfPage](https://www.cms.gov/EHRIncentivePrograms/15_Eligibility.asp#TopOfPage).
2. Enroll in PECOS (link to <https://pecos.cms.hhs.gov/pecos/login.do>) if you have not already done so. This is a step that must precede registration for the EHR Incentive Programs.
3. Register for the incentive programs on the CMS website (link to [https://www.cms.gov/EHRIncentivePrograms/20\\_RegistrationandAttestation.asp#TopOfPage](https://www.cms.gov/EHRIncentivePrograms/20_RegistrationandAttestation.asp#TopOfPage) ). If you are participating in the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program, you must also [visit https://www.cms.gov/EHRIncentivePrograms/40\\_MedicaidStateInfo.asp#TopOfPage](https://www.cms.gov/EHRIncentivePrograms/40_MedicaidStateInfo.asp#TopOfPage) for information on how to register.
